


Fig2.1: Flowchart of Proposed System




Fig3.1.1: Client-Server Architecture

The above figure 4.1 shows the login page of owner, only the already registered business owner can login to the system by entering his\her user name and password.




Fig4.2: Business Owner Registration

The above figure 4.3 shows, home screen of business owner, where he\she can add a product by clicking on the add button.




Fig4.4: Business Owner Home Screen




Fig4.11: Product Detail

The above figure 4.11 shows, product detail screen, this operation comes under the member where BO can view the feedback of member through like, comments.




Fig4.12: Member Home Screen
